



OUR PRIORITIES


When Jesus first visited the home of Mary and Martha, what did each sister think was the most important thing to do? Which one did Jesus agree with, and why? [Read Luke 10:38-42.](#)

Name some important things that you must do each day. Which ones are most important? [Read Luke 10:27-28.](#)

Today, we cannot literally sit at Jesus' feet like Mary did—yet it is important to spend time with Him every day. What are some ways we can do that? [Read Acts 2:42.](#)

If you cut down a grapevine, can it grow any more fruit? Why is it so important for us to stay closely connected to our Lord and Savior? [Read John 15:4-5.](#)

PRAY Lord Jesus, remind us to spend time with You by studying the Bible, praying, and meeting with other Christians to grow in our faith. Amen.



GOD'S TIMING

At the beginning of the video, what did Joy think was the most important thing she had to do? Why did she change her mind later? [Read Isaiah 55:8-9.](#)

Can you think of any stories in the Bible that tell about Jesus meeting sick people? What happened? [Read Matthew 4:23-24.](#)

Do you believe Jesus could have healed Lazarus? Why do you think Jesus waited to visit His good friend? [Read John 11:1-6.](#)

Have you ever felt frustrated or upset because something wasn't happening the way you planned, only to find out later that things worked out for the best? [Read Romans 8:28.](#)

What should we do whenever we are worried or anxious? [Read 1 Peter 5:7.](#)

PRAY Heavenly Father, Your ways are higher than our ways, and Your thoughts are higher than ours. Help us trust You even when things seem to go wrong. Amen.



NEW LIFE

Does Jesus understand how we feel when we are sad and sorrowful? Why do you think He wept at Lazarus' tomb? [Read John 11:33-35.](#)

What did Jesus tell Martha about rising from the dead? [Read John 11:21-26.](#)

Did Martha believe Jesus? Do you think she had any doubts? [Read John 11:27, 39-40.](#)

Imagine that you were near the tomb when Lazarus came out. What would you believe about Jesus? [Read John 20:31.](#)

When Jesus died on the cross to pay the punishment for our sins, did He stay dead? What do we receive when we believe in Him? [Read John 3:16, Colossians 1:13-14.](#)

PRAY Jesus, we thank You for dying for our sins. We praise You for conquering death by rising from the grave so we can have eternal life! Amen.
