Read Hebrews 4:12.

Chris and Joy had seen God work throughout the Bible, and they had experienced Him in their lives. Choose some of your favorite Bible stories and tell how God worked in each one.

Read Hebrews 11:7-13, 17-34.

God's Word has incredible power! What happened each time God spoke in the very beginning? **Read Genesis 1:3-26.** 

The Bible is God's Word that has been written down. How does knowing God's Word help us in our lives today?

Read Psalm 119:11, 105.

PRAY Lord God, plant the truth of Your Word deep in our hearts to give us Your guidance, power, peace and protection. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

God loves to reveal Himself to those who seek Him! How does He do this? **Read 1 Thessalonians 1:4-6 and 1 Corinthians 2:10.**

Jesus had prepared His followers for situations just like that. Do you know what He said? **Read Luke 21:12-19.** 

How do you think Paul knew what to say to the people of Athens? **Read James 1:5.** 

What did Paul say in his sermon, and how did people react? **Read Acts 17:22-34.** 

What does God's power help us do? Read Acts 1:8.

PRAY Heavenly Father, thank You for sending Your Spirit to fill us with power and courage to share Your Good News with others. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.
