Why were Roman soldiers guarding Jesus' tomb? **Read Matthew 27:62-66.**


Why did the religious leaders pay the soldiers to lie? **Read Matthew 28:11-15.**

How did Thomas feel when he saw Jesus? Read John 20:26-28.


On the road to Emmaus, what were the followers of Jesus discussing? **Read Luke 24:13-24.**

What did Jesus explain to them?

Read Luke 24:25-27; Isaiah 53; Psalm 22.

How did they finally recognize Jesus? Read Luke 24:28-32.

PRAY Lord Jesus, thank You for loving us so much that You chose to pay the price for our sins by dying on the cross. We love you! Amen.



POWERFUL FAITH

When the men in Emmaus recognized Jesus, what did they do? Read Luke 24:33-35.


Just before Jesus rose up to heaven, He gave His disciples the most important job in the world—and it's also our job today! What is it? **Read Luke 24:44-49; Mark 16:15.**

How can we overcome every doubt and problem that we may face? **Read 1 John 5:4-5**.

Jesus told Thomas about a special blessing that is ours today. What is it? **Read John 20:29**.

Although we can't see Jesus with our physical eyes, we can see Him with our eyes of faith. What does God give us to build our faith? **Read John 20:30-31; Jude 1:20.**

PRAY Heavenly Father, fill us with the power of Your Word and Your Spirit to share the Good News about Jesus with others! In His name we pray. Amen.
